One Book, One Read Did You Know?

- All of GA's students are thoroughly enjoying reading, Mrs. Frisby and the Rats of NIMH!
- At this time we are on Chapter 21 and are almost finished!
- Did you know...On **Feb. 22** Sandy Messerly, the storyteller from the assembly, will be here to talk to the different grade levels. In grades, K-3 she will be working with the students on the setting of the story and imagination. In grades 4-8, Sandy will be covering character development in a story and specifically Mrs. Frisby. Visualization will be discussed.
- Did you know...1st grade has discussed reading excerpts and is having students complete a reader response and illustration to the excerpts.
- Did you know... Junior high Religion classes are discussing the moral dilemmas that are related to the story but also pertinent today. In Reading, students will discuss the story, identify figurative language, point of view, character development, idioms, etc.
