One Book, One Read--All of GA's students are thoroughly enjoying reading, *Mrs. Frisby and the Rats of NIMH*! At this time we are almost finished!

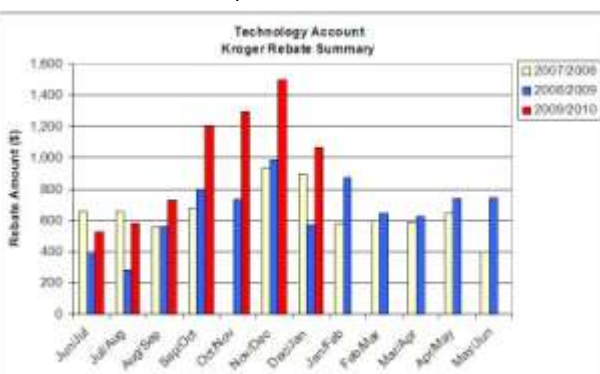
