Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q. The golf team is for what grade level(s)?

A. The golf team consists of boys and girls from 7th and 8th grade.

Q. Teams are a combination of several grades or separated by grade?

A. One golf team consisting of boys and girls from 7th and 8th grade.

Q. If applicable, how many teams per grade?

A. Not applicable.

Q. Teams are created by skill or teams are balanced by skill?

A. One golf team consisting of boys and girls from 7th and 8th grade.

Q. Teams selected by skill are determined in what manner.

A. Not applicable.

Q. Does my child need to be experienced in the sport?

A. Yes, the golf team is for children whom have experience with the sport and can break 60 on a regulation 9-hole course. Golfers are expected to supply their own clubs.

Q. Season start date and end date?

A. Late August to early October

Q. Tournaments which may occur before or after regular season?

A. No additional tournaments; however, an optional parent/child scramble may be scheduled at the end of the season.

Q. Practice start date?

A. Two instructional clinics are held in early August before the season starts. No practice is held once the season begins ... only matches.

Q. Practices are typically how many days per week?

A. Two instructional clinics are held in early August before the season starts. No practice is held once the season begins ... only matches.

Q. Practices will start at what time, where, and last for how long?

A. Two instructional clinics at a location to be determined are held in early August before the season starts. No practice is held once the season begins ... only matches.

Q. Games or matches are typically played when? Where?

A. Matches are scheduled after school at public par 3 courses like Reeves or Little Miami Golf Course.

Q. A typical season has how many games or matches per season.

A. Each golfer will play seven or eight matches depending on overall scheduling success with other school programs. Each match will consist of six GA golfers.

Q. What are CYO playing time regulations?

A. Golf is not a recognized CYO sport but a league created amongst area schools with an interest in the sport. Therefore, there are no playing time regulations mandated by CYO.

Q. What are GA playing time regulations?

A. Each golfer is scheduled the same number of matches during the season. Each match will have six GA golfers. Golfers may play with different teammates at each match depending on team size and schedule.

Q. How are coaches selected?

A. GA asks for volunteers from our parent community and we attempt to select most qualified individual(s).

Q. How many coaches?

A. GA requires two adults to be present at all practices and matches/games. We have one or two coaches or a coach and a parent assistant for the golf team.

Q. Can parents coach?

A. Yes.

Q. Whom do I contact about volunteering to coach?

A. Contact any GA Athletic Booster or the Booster member designated as the Booster Director of Golf. To find current board member listing and director assignments, go to
